WHAT IS CUB SCOUT & WEBELOS SCOUT RESIDENT CAMP?

Cub Scout & Webelos Scout Resident Camp is a South Texas Council summer camp program for Tiger Cubs, Cub Scouts and Webelos Scouts plus their parents, leaders, and family members. It is a three day and two night summer camp at Camp Karankawa on beautiful Lake Corpus Christi (near Mathis, TX) designed to help Cub Scouts have a great summer camp adventure and get a big head start on their next school year Scouting advancements.

This year's camp will have the theme of **A Super Hero Summer**. At camp Cub Scouts will participate in program areas like: Showmanship, Sportsmanship, Craftsmanship, Campcraft and Nature; plus many traditional camp activities such as swimming, boating, fishing, shooting sports and much more. Scouts and participants are encouraged to bring and wear their favorite super hero costume to camp. You just might see one of your favorite super heroes trekking through camp.

To ensure a quality experience, this camp will be limited to the first 100 paid Scouts, plus their family and leaders.

THREE WAYS TO ATTEND

There are three ways to attend the Super Hero Summer Resident Camp.

1. A Cub Scout can attend with an adult family member (approved by the parent).
2. A Cub Scout can attend with his entire family.
3. A Den or Pack can come to camp with a minimum of two adult leaders while maintaining a ratio of boys to adults of at least 4 to 1. 2012-2013 school year Tiger Cubs must use options 1 or 2.

COST TO ATTEND CAMP

The Super Hero Summer camp fee includes the cost of 7 meals and 2 cracker barrels (night time snacks); craft & other program supplies; insurance; camp patch for each person and much more. The camps fees are:

Cub Scouts:	\$105
Sibling 5 years and older fully participating in crafts and all activities	\$105
Tag-a-longs (all meals and partial participation in activities)	\$50
Adults	\$50

A late fee of \$25 per person will be assessed after June 22, 2012.

CHECK-IN & CHECK-OUT

Check-in and camp set-up will begin on Thursday morning, July 5th from 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM. Camp will end Saturday afternoon, July 7th.

Each person attending the Super Hero Summer camp must complete and submit (with registration a BSA Health History Form. This form and any prescription medications must be turned into the Camp Medic upon arrival at camp. Prescription medications must be in their original containers and will be dispensed by the camp medic according to the instructions on the container. It is recommended that individuals with multiple medication to place all of their meds in a zip top plastic bag with their name clearly written on the outside of the bag.

ADULTS: Besides health form(s) must submit proof of New Youth Protection Training Classroom Course and Sex Offenders Search results.

MEALS

The first meal served will be lunch on July 5th. The last meal served will be lunch on July 7th. All meals will be prepared and served for you in the camp dining hall. The menu will feature nutritious and delicious kid friendly meals. The camp will make reasonable accommodations for those

individuals with special meal requests for religious or medical reasons. Special meal requests must be submitted in writing to the Scout Service Center before July 1, 2012 to allow time to adjust menus and food ordering.

All meals in addition to the main entrée and side dishes will include a PB&J sandwich bar. All lunches and suppers will include a salad bar.

WHAT NOT TO BRING TO CAMP

Alcoholic beverages, drugs, etc.

Guns, archery equipment, etc.

Pets, dogs, cats, hamsters, etc.

Items not conducive to Scouting.

WHERE WILL I CAMP???

When you arrive at camp you will be assigned to a Super Hero SummerCrew. Each crew will consist of 8 to 10 Cub Scouts plus their parents, siblings and leaders. We will keep families from the same Cub Scout Pack on the same crew. 2 or 3 crews will camp together in one of the camp's central campsites as a group. The purpose of the crews is to foster an environment for the families to build new friendships and as a way to evenly distribute the participants across the activity areas to avoid over crowding and to ensure a quality experience.

TEXAS YOUTH CAMP SAFETY AND HEALTH ACT

Texas state law demands that all adults attending the KARANKAWA ADVENTURE must go to the Texas Department of Public Safety's on-line Sex Offender website and print out a certificate showing that they ARE NOT a registered sex offender.
