DATES: Wednesday December 26th to Monday morning December 31st

LOCATION: Camp Karankawa, Lake Corpus Christi, Mathis, TX

WHO MAY ATTEND? First 275 Paid Boy Scout Registrants.

COST: Early Registration Fee \$135 camper fee due by Nov. 30th and \$45 leader fee due by Nov.30th.

Regular Registration Fee \$145 after Nov. 30th (If space is available) including \$50 leader fee.

PROGRAM: A unique part of Winter Camp is that it offers great opportunities for Scouts to focus on their personal advancement needs and participate in other merit badge offerings they find of interest... AND unit leaders serve as the merit badge program instructors. In 2011, over 39 merit badges were offered including 11 Eagle required badges. For 2012, we would like to offer even more! Thus, <u>EVERY UNIT NEEDS TO PROVIDE AT LEAST ONE MERIT BADGE INSTRUCTOR</u>, <u>PERFERABLY MORE TO MAKE THIS HAPPEN</u>.

Lake High Adventure Program. A two day and one night kayak or canoe trek on Lake Corpus Christi. Scouts will kayak/canoe to and explore several islands on the lake. They will also have plenty of fishing opportunities and will spend the night at Lake Corpus Christi State Park. Scouts will complete a service project at the park before returning back to camp. Participation requirements: Be at least 13 years old, have swimming merit badge or be able to pass the swimmers test. A personal equipment list will be included in the Leader's Guidebook.

REFUND/TRANSFER POLICY

Written refund requests received at the Scout Service Center more than 35 days before the first day of camp will be refunded in their entirety accept for \$35.00

Written refund requests received at the Scout Service Center 35 days or less before the first day of camp and more than 48 hours before the participant's scheduled arrival at camp will be refunded in their entirety except for \$65.

Written refund requests received at the Scout Service Center or at camp less than 48 hours before the participant's arrival at camp and up to an including the first meal of the camp season will be refunded in their entirety except for \$100.

Written refund requests will be granted, unquestioned, according to the guidelines outlined above. Pre-paid camp fees may be transferred to another Scout within the same Scouting unit without penalty. This refund policy is being enacted to provide the maximum flexibility to Scouts and their families while protecting the council's pre-paid camp expenses based on the unit's reservation numbers.
