Camp Karankawa

DATES: Check in on the afternoon of Saturday, July 6th from 1-2 pm & departure on Sunday, July 7th after 3pm

LOCATION: Camp Karankawa, Lake Corpus Christi, Mathis, TX

WHO MAY ATTEND: First 150 paid youth registrants.

COST: Cost is \$60 per youth and \$30 per adult by July 1st. Fees include 3 meals, a patch, and program supplies. Units can make a \$100 deposit to reserve a campsite; deposit will be deducted from total fees due.

REFUNDS: Refer to the council event refund policy found on the council website at www.southtexasbsa.org.

PROGRAM REVIEW: New for summer 2013, outdoor leadership and skills camp program for members of registered Venture Crews and Explorer Posts. The South Texas Council is organizing a two day and one night camp program designed to give older youth an opportunity to work on leadership and outdoor recreation skills. Program areas that campers will experience include the C.O.P.E course, shooting sports, aquatics including swimming instruction, introduction to snorkeling, canoeing, rowing, kayaking, and small boat sailing. All programs will be conducted and supervised by the experienced and trained youth and adult staff of Camp Karankawa.

All participants wanting to participate in aquatic activities must take the BSA swimmers qualification test on Saturday morning. BSA swim test requirements can be found at <http://www.scouting.org/scoutsource/healthandsafety/gss/gss02.aspx>.

Participants will be able to sign up for individual and group activities. Program activity schedule will be published and sent to crew and post advisors prior to arriving to camp.

Youth Protection guidelines at camp: All units must have at least two adult leaders over the age of 21 years old at camp at all times. Units with youth female participants must have one female adult leader in camp at all times. All youth protection camping and activity requirements must be followed while at camp. All youth age 18 or older and adult leaders must have submit a copy of a current TX Edition YPT certification card, a DPS sex offender check, and the Adult in Camp state compliance form before arriving at camp.

Medical Health Forms: All youth and adult camp participants must submit a completed BSA Health & Medical Record Form (A & B) during check in. You may download a form from our council's website: www.southtexasbsa.org – Under RESOURCES – and then – FOR UNITS.

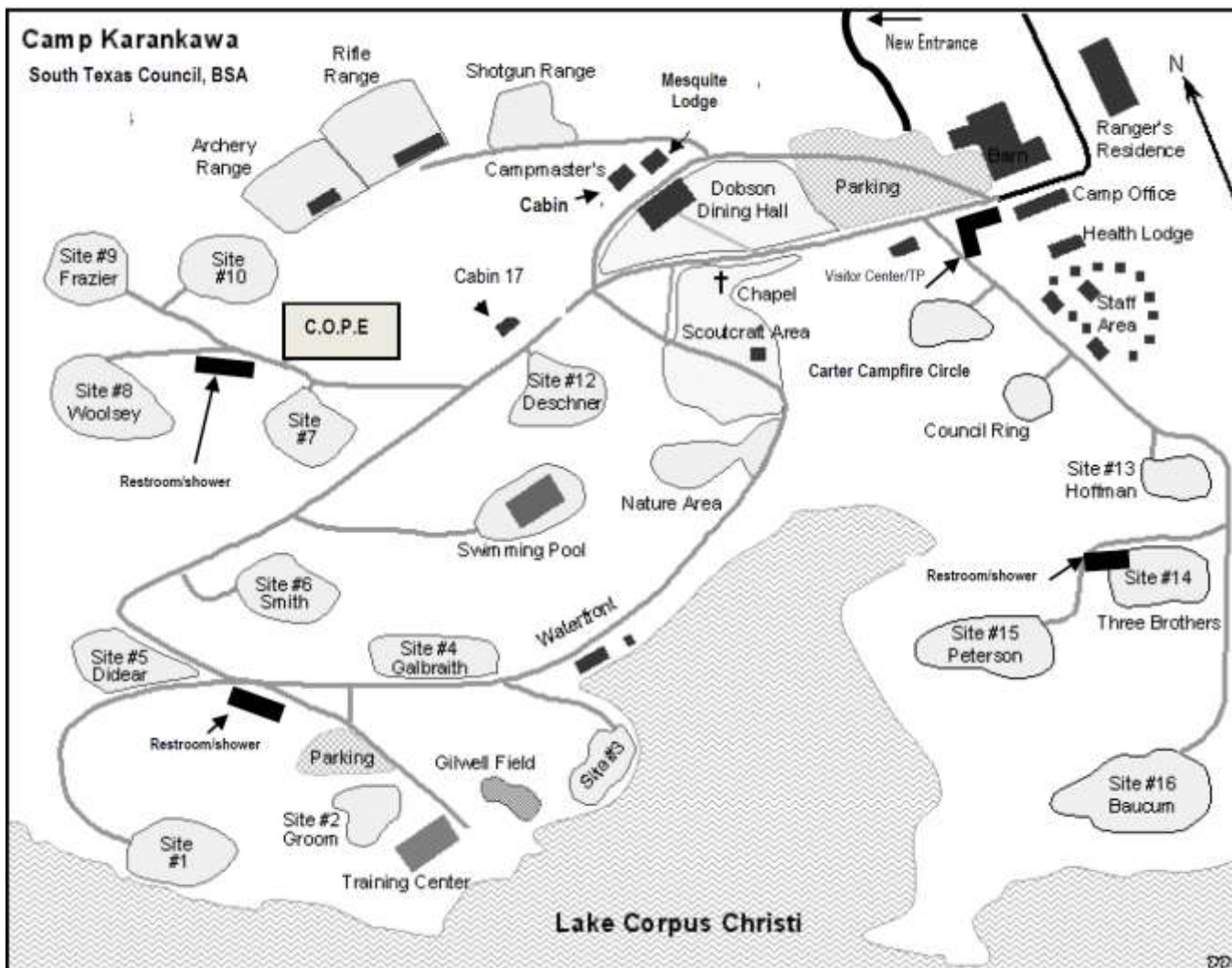

Directions to Camp Karankawa

Directions from Corpus Christi

Travel north on Interstate 37 to Mathis, Texas.
 Take exit 34 towards Lake Corpus Christi Recreation Area.
 Turn left at State Highway 359. Travel on State Highway 359 south to Mathis until you cross the first bridge.
 Turn right as soon as you cross the bridge.
 Follow this road until you come to the entrance leading to the Lake Corpus Christi State Park.
 Turn left into the entrance to the park.
 Proceed towards the park until you reach the fork in the road.
 Take the right fork past the State Park to the Camp Karankawa entrance on the left.

Directions from Victoria

Take US 59 south to Beeville (55 miles). Take US 181 south to Skidmore (12 miles).
 Follow TX 359 southwest into Mathis. Travel on State Highway 359 south to Mathis until you cross the first bridge.
 Turn right as soon as you cross the bridge. Follow this road until you come to the entrance leading to the Lake Corpus Christi State Park. Turn left into the entrance to the park. Proceed towards the park until you reach the fork in the road. Take the right fork past the State Park to the Camp Karankawa entrance on the left.

Directions from Laredo

Take US 59 north to Freer. Take State Hwy 44 east to Alice. Take TX 359 north to Mathis.
 Cross the Nueces River Bridge and then turn left at Park Road 25. Follow this road until you come to the entrance leading to the Lake Corpus Christi State Park. Turn left into the entrance to the park.
 Proceed towards the park until you reach the fork in the road.
 Take the right fork past the State Park to the Camp Karankawa entrance on the left.
